

Algonquin Township Trustee Position Available

Algonquin Township is currently accepting applications for an opening of an Algonquin Township Trustee position for the remainder of the term ending in May 2021.

Minimum qualifications for the Algonquin Township Trustee Position:

- **Must be a legal voter. (60 ILCS 1/55-5)**
- **Must have lived in Algonquin Township for a minimum of one (1) year prior to appointment. (60 ILCS 1/55-5.)**
- **Must be a member of the same political party as the person vacating the office. (60 ILCS 1/60-5.)**

In this case, a **Republican**. Republican Party affiliation will be determined by his or her record of voting in party primary elections or by holding or having held an office in the Republican organization before appointment. If the appointee has not voted in a party primary election or is not holding or has not helped an office in the Republican political party organization before appointment, then appointee shall establish his or her political party affiliation by his or her record of participating in a Republican political party's nomination or election caucus.

Those interested in being appointed to the position of Algonquin Township Trustee should complete an application for this position along with including a resume (if available) for consideration. Applications are available on our website at algonquintownship.com, or at the Algonquin Township Office. Applicants must be Algonquin Township residents, registered voters, and be of the same political party as the previous office-holder (Republican). Incomplete and/or un-signed applications will not be considered.
